- ☐ Attend EVERY class, EVERY day.
- ☐ Arrive at school on time.
- ☐ Bring glasses and assistive technology/devices each day.
- ☐ Bring a water bottle every day.
- ☐ Meet with the teacher early to discuss your child's unique talents and needs. Request a meeting through Class Dojo.
- ☐ Sign up for **Power School** grade notifications.
- ☐ Sign up for **Class Dojo** to stay updated on important announcements and student celebrations.
- ☐ Coach your child at home for 10 minutes, daily, using the Home Packets.
- ☐ Read the decodable passage from the Home Packet every night (reread 3-5 times per week).
- ☐ Attend tutoring.
- ☐ Make up missed Math work in IXL (assignments are under "Teacher Recommendations" on the student dashboard).
- ☐ Attend Parent Conferences and IEP meetings.
- ☐ Give the teacher feedback about what is going well, and what you would like to change (via text, Dojo, call, or email).
- ☐ Let the teacher know immediately if there are changes at home that might affect your child. Remember that the teacher is on your team, and is here to help!
- ☐ At home, communicate high expectations for academic achievement and behavior.
