STAFF & STUDENTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Persons who test positive for COVID-19 must quarantine/isolate for 5 days. ➤ If after 5 days, the patient is asymptomatic or has resolving symptoms, their isolation period is over. ➤ All persons who test positive for COVID-19 will be required to wear a mask while around other people during Days 6 through 10. Day 0 is defined as either the date of symptom onset, or the date the test specimen was collected if the patient is asymptomatic. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Persons who have received a booster vaccine and more than 2 weeks have passed Note: Heterologous (mix-and-match) dosing may occur for the booster dose. ➤ People who have completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months and thus are not yet eligible for the booster vaccination; ➤ People who have completed the primary series of the J&J vaccine within the last 2 months; 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ People who have completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago and have not received a booster vaccination; ➤ People who have completed the primary series of the J&J vaccine over 2 months ago and are not boosted; ➤ People who are not vaccinated.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ All exposed persons, regardless of vaccination status, should test on Day 5 if possible. ➤ If someone develops symptoms consistent with COVID-19, testing is recommended on Day 5 if possible, regardless of vaccination status or prior infection. 		
Close Contact	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Upon discovery of a positive case in a school or classroom, parents of close contacts will be notified of the positive case and provided an option for their child to quarantine (excused absences) for a period of 1-10 calendar days) or continue to attend school provided the student remains asymptomatic. Parents are asked to monitor their child daily for a period of 1-14 days following an exposure. If the child develops symptoms consistent with COVID-19, they are to keep their child home and notify the school nurse immediately. <p><i>In the K–12 indoor classroom setting, the close contact definition excludes students who were within 3 to 6 feet of an infected student (laboratory-confirmed or a clinically compatible illness) if both the infected student and exposed student(s) correctly and consistently wore well-fitting masks the entire time. This exception does not apply to teachers, staff, or other adults in the indoor classroom setting.</i></p>
