5th Grade Book Report Schedule

Rubrics, further instructions, and details for each book report will be handed out for each report at the beginning of the month.

September: Realistic Fiction

Students will create a diorama in a shoe box to resemble a scene from their realistic fiction story after reading their book. **5**. **RF.4**. They will write a summary of the story using a beginning, middle, and end. **5**. **W.4**. They will present this to the class. **5**. **SL.5**, **5**.**SL.6**.

Due: September 29th

October: Mystery

Students will create a DVD cover for their mystery book that they have read. **5. RF. 4.** The front will have a nice, colorful picture. The title and author should be listed on the spine and the student will write a summary of the book on the back cover. **5. W. 4, 5.W.5**

Due: October 27th

November-December: Statuaries

Students will be reporting on a famous person in history after reading their book **5.RF.4.** Using appropriate facts and dressing up in costume as their character and presenting a 1-2 minute speech to others. **5. SL.4., 5.SL.5, 5.SL.6, 5.W. 7**

Due: December 8th

January: Adventure Book

Students will choose and read an adventure book. 5. RF.4. They will create a game board using facts and information. 5. W.1b.,5.W.2b. Students will include a page giving directions to the players as well.

Due: January 31st

February: Non-Fiction Animal Report

Students will choose and read a nonfiction book about an animal. **5.RF.4.** They will complete a report teaching the class about the animal of their choice. **5. W. 1b, 5. W.2b** They will also create an animal mosaic poster and present to the class.

Due: February 28th

March: Poem

Students will memorize and recite a poem. **5. RF.4, 5. RL.5, 5.RL.1.** When presenting the poem they will need to remember the characteristics of a good presentation. Poems should be a minimum of 10 lines long.

Due: March 23rd

April: Biography

Students will choose and read a biography book and complete a character report. **5. RF. 4.** This is the same format as the statuaries with the exception that students will also create a bottle person to resemble their character **5.SL.4**, **5.SL.5.**, **5. SL.6**, **5.W.7**
