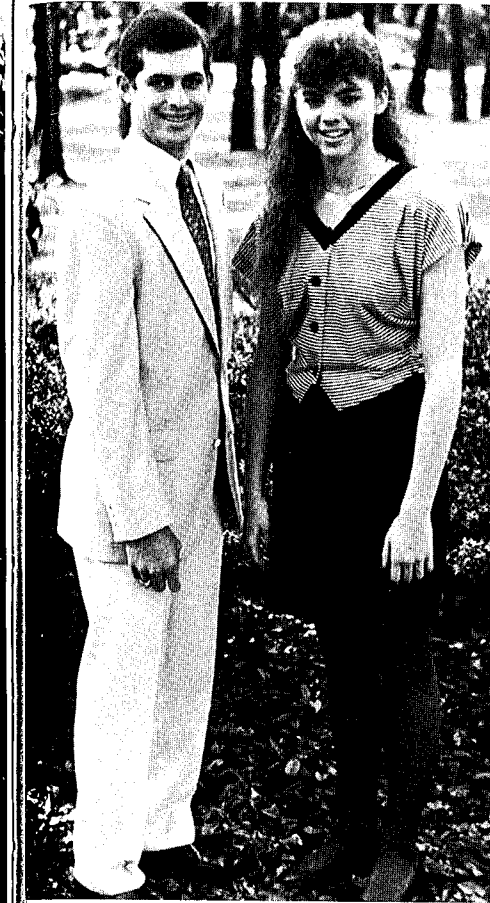

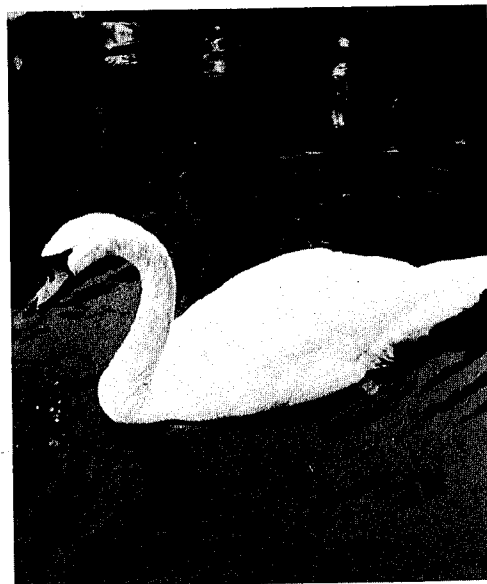

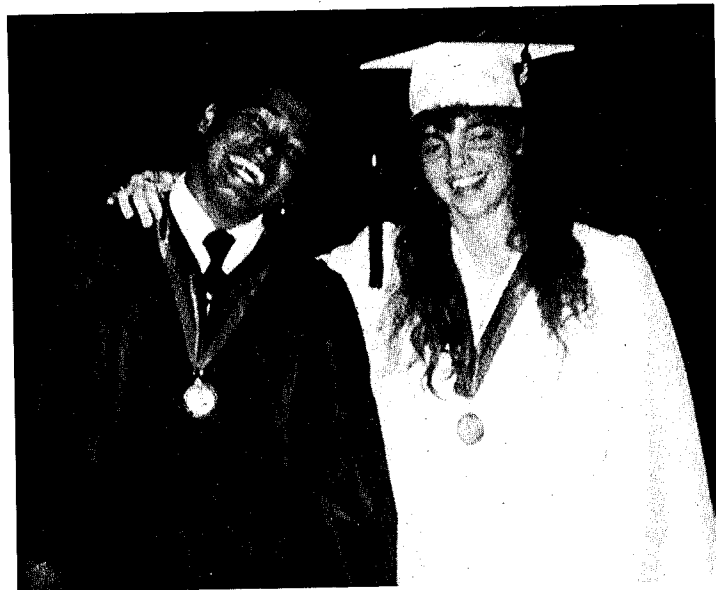


# Baccalaureate

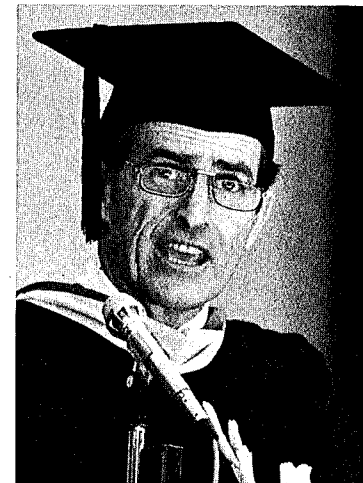

## '88-'89 Happenings

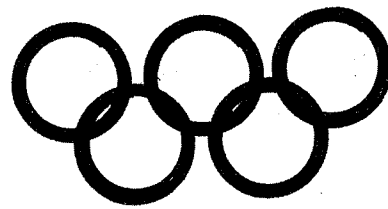

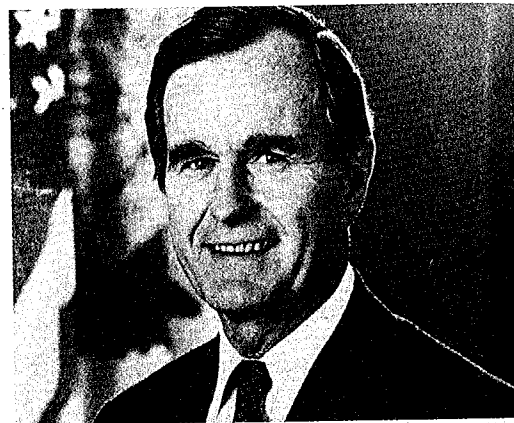
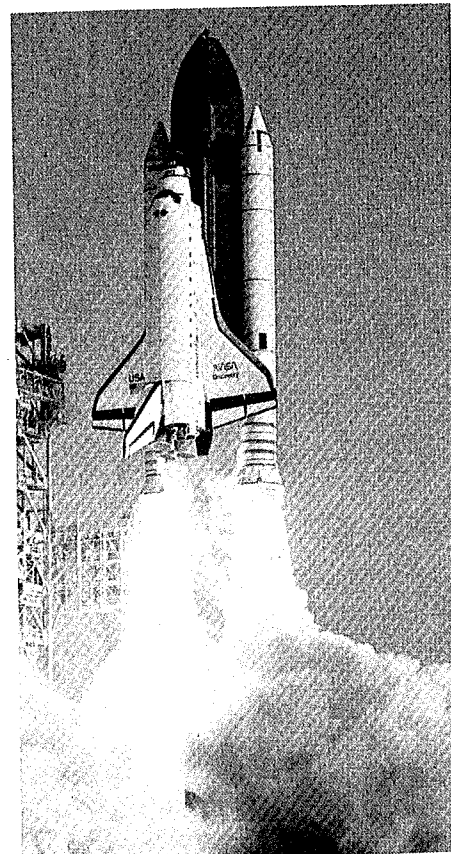
One of the most prominent events of the year was the rebirth of the space program. The Space Shuttle finally regained flight for the first time since the tragedy in 1986.

No true sports fan would have let this year pass without watching the incredible Michael Jordan shoot the basketball. He was probably the most famed sports figure in 1989.

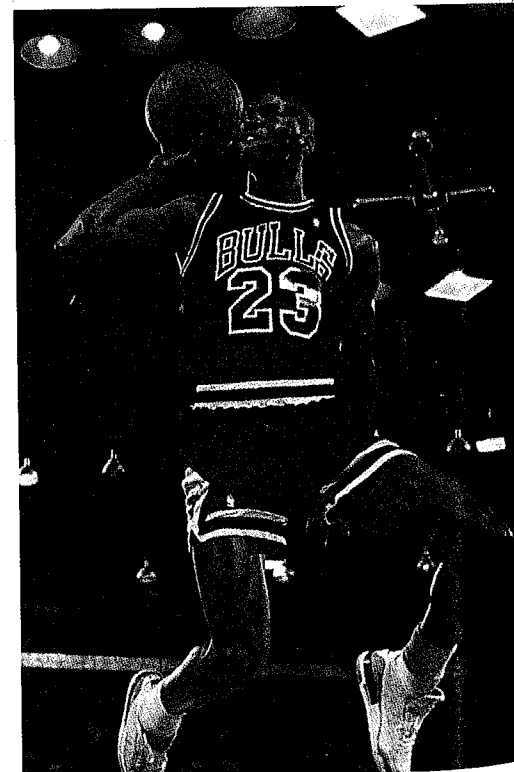
