The Randolph County Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, August 20, 2007, at 6 p.m. at the Jaycee Building.

Call to Order

Chairperson LaVerne Williams called the meeting to order. Board members in attendance were as follows: P. Guthrie, G. Cook, T. McDonald, G. Lawson, J. Johnson, and B. Coltrane.

The Board observed a Moment of Silence before beginning the meeting.

Board Spotlight

Cathy Brady, Director of Elementary Education, and Ana Floyd, Lead Teacher, introduced Math Teacher of the Year, Gwen Hall. Mrs. Hall has taught for 29 years at New Market Elementary School. She has her National Board Certification and is currently working on her Master's Degree. She has conducted local and state workshops training teachers on how to teach math.

Superintendent Donald Andrews recognized Board Member Paul Guthrie, who retired as an educator from the school system with 30 plus years of service. Mr. Guthrie was recently named Trinity Citizen of the Year. Mr. Guthrie shared that when he moved into the Trinity Area, he found that the community embraced teachers and education. He joined the faculty at Trinity High School, quickly become involved in community activities, and joined the local Rotary Club. He stated that his career and his community activities gave him the opportunity to be of service to the community.

North Carolina High School Graduate Survey/Scholarship Information

Kim Johnson, Director of High School Education, shared 2007 graduating class statistical information: 1,046 diplomas were issued, 21 certificates were issued, 6 foreign exchange students received a certificate, 38.2% are going to public and/or private four-year colleges, 48.7% are going to community colleges, private junior colleges, and trade schools; 3.5 % are entering the military, and 8.2% are entering the workforce. The total monies awarded to Randolph County graduates toward furthering their education was \$8,653,721.50.

NCHSAA Academic Survey

Mrs. Johnson also reported that athletes accounted for 20% of the total high school population. The grade point average of athletes on a 4.0 scale was 3.3 compared with 2.5 for non-athletes. Athletes averaged 4.2 day absence while non-athletes averaged 9.3 days absent per year. The dropout rate for athletes was 0.30% compared to 8.9% for non-athletes. The graduation rate for senior athletes was 97.9% while the rate for senior non-athletes was 89.4%.

Board Stipends

The Superintendent reported that the stipends for board members - \$200 per month for members and \$300 per month for the chair – had been reviewed and that he recommended that he be allowed to present to the County Commissioners a request for increasing the stipends to \$300 per month for members and \$400 per month for the board chair. Mr. Andrews stated that the amounts, even with an increase, would be much less than what the system would pay members if they were paid for mileage to attend the many meetings and events required of them as board members. P. Guthrie made a motion seconded by T. McDonald to approve the recommendation as presented. The motion carried: 6-1 (Lawson).
