This weekend, we celebrate Trinity Sunday. We don't celebrate a mere doctrine but who God is in Himself. The Holy Trinity is three Persons united in one existence or being. This is beyond our ability to understand, in fact St. Thomas Aquinas taught that if we claim to understand the mystery of the Trinity, we reveal that we have something less than God.

What we celebrate is who God is in Himself – His internal reality, not just what He does. As such, as I continue to 'harp' on, it is not sufficient to call God "Creator, Redeemer, and Sanctifier" as that is what God does, further, all three Persons were active in their own way in each of those acts. But God is Father who eternally begets the Son, Son who is eternally begotten by the Father, and the Holy Spirit who is the Love that proceeds from the Father and the Son.

They are co-equal, but they are separate persons, meaning the Father is not the Son nor the Spirit, the Son is not the Father nor the Spirit, and the Spirit is not the Father nor the Son, yet all three are God. Who they are is a community of love, united in one being. And we as creatures are redeemed and sanctified to share in their divine life. That is our hope and destiny.

At time of writing, I have received 2 inquiries about the Director of Religious Education position. Please pray the right person will come forward and be identified.

Next week, we will host our annual Mission Appeal and have Fr. Jerry Stookey OP with us to present on the missions of the Dominicans in Puerto Rico. Please prayerfully consider making a contribution to this mission next week.

DOMINICAN FRIARS' MISSION APPEAL

Fr. Jerry Stookey from the St. Dominic Mission Society will be here on June 18 and 19. He is the director of the St. Dominic Mission Society. St. Dominic Mission Society is the foreign mission organization of the Dominican Friars of the Province of St. Albert the Great (Central USA).

Presently the greatest needs there are:

- Casa de Predicación (House of Preaching) which is a retreat center in Bayamón severely damaged by Hurricane María in 2017. Funding is needed for restoration and especially for training catechists of children with disabilities.
- Grade school and Dominican priory of our parish Nuestra Señora del Rosario in Yauco, which was severely damaged by a 6.7 magnitude earthquake in January 2020. The historic church has been successfully restored and opened in March 2022. However, funding is still needed, especially to restore and save our grade school.
- We seek your prayers for our vocations and ministries in Puerto Rico, as well as your charitable donations for this mission. Thank you for your support and prayers.
