### \* To be eligible for our program:

- 1. The family must qualify for FREE lunches by HIF Lunch Forms.
- 2. The family cannot be receiving assistance from any other Christmas program.
- The children must be enrolled in <u>Ballard County Schools</u>.
- For children who are too young for school, parents must bring proof of Medicaid or SNAP benefits from Ballard County DCBS.
- \* Santa's Workshop: <u>A parent or guardian</u> must attend <u>1</u> of the workshops in order to be eligible for our Christmas assistance. <u>ALL WORKSHOPS ARE BEING HELD AT</u>
