Dear Parishioners,

June 30 is the last day of the fiscal year 2023-2024. Most years, this involves bookkeepers doing the end of the year reimbursements and assuring that everything is accounted for as we begin a new fiscal year, but this year, there is the added work of transitioning to a new accounting system at the request of the Office of Finance of the Diocese of New Ulm.

We are moving from QuickBooks to ParishSoft, and in the coming months we will be implementing various elements of the software such as Payroll (which assists in tax withholdings and all the other intricacies with payroll) and census keeping. For us, it is a lateral move once all these elements are setup and implemented, but for now, there is much to learn to do as the system is different. Caren will need to continue to use Quickbooks for payroll until the end of the calendar year, but also use ParishSoft starting July 1 for the reports. Please keep her and all our parish bookkeepers of the Diocese in prayer.

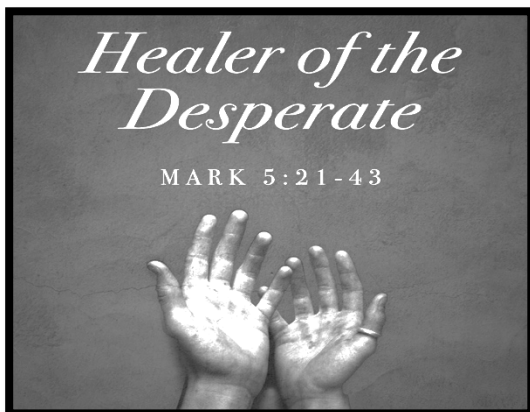
On Thursday we celebrate Independence Day. I am often struck with both the youth of the founders of our country (Monroe was 18, Hamilton was 21-23, Madison wasn't 25, Adams was 40, and Washington was 44 in 1776) as well as the wisdom. In establishing this republic, they knew that done right, it would be the model of freedom to the world, and if it were to fail, would harm many.

Lately, even reminding people that we have a republic is seen as controversial. Yet that is what our nation is, as we elect officials who make laws (the legislature) and execute them (the executive branch), with the co-equal judicial branch that judges if the laws are in line with the Constitution. We are not a democracy – we are not ruled by the majority.

Though there may be a majority party in power, they are only representatives of the people, and their votes do not always reflect the will (or even the good) of the people. That is why we need to be vigilant and hold our elected officials accountable, to make our voices heard on key issues such as protection of the unborn or the vulnerable. A republic works only if we seek to be better. We have a republic, if we can keep it, as Dr. Benjamin Franklin (who happened to be the oldest signer of the Declaration at the age of 70) answered when asked what kind of nation we would have.

Let's pray for this great nation, for her people and leaders, that we may together seek peace and justice.
