Good afternoon Everyone,

We are so excited to see our students this week! This past week marked our first FULL 5-day week in school since we began on August 4th! We are facing so many things daily, but one thing we can all agree upon is that our students deserve the very best education. I thank you all for making school a priority for your children!

Because we have had interruptions to the calendar since we began on August 4th, please note that your child's progress report (coming home on September 7th) may not include as many grades as we would normally have at this point in time. Disruptions to the calendar included closing in person learning for three days and closure for the tropical storm on another day. Many of your children have also had to quarantine due to direct contact or positive COVID test results, and they may have missing assignments from these factors. We are being understanding and are committed to working with the students to get these assignments completed. Also, the Google Classroom assignments are for those students that are quarantined due to COVID exposure or a positive test, the Google Classroom is not an option for students that have an appointment or go out of town, etc. and will be out of school. FROM MS. MCBRIDE...

As kids today are confronted with new and unfamiliar issues about returning to school when compared with kids in any recent years, it is apparent that we must identify different ways and strategies to help motivate them. The ups and downs of the pandemic has created a lack of consistency and routine, which can make it difficult for some to stay on task and be motivated.

Here at SGSC, we want to help our students stay engaged and motivated to learn, and we need parents help to achieve this goal. As a parent, your presence in the academic life of your child is crucial to their commitment to work. Here are a few tips of things that you can do to help motivate your child.

Get Involved

- Do homework with them, and let them know that you're available to answer questions. Get in the habit of asking them about what they learned in school. By demonstrating your interest in your child's school life, you're showing them school can be exciting and interesting. This is especially effective with young kids who tend to be excited about whatever you're excited about. Teenagers can shut down if they feel you are asking too many questions, so make sure you are sharing the details of your day, too. A
 - conversation is always better than an interrogation.

Reward effort rather than outcome

• The message you want to send is that you respect hard work. Praising kids for following through when things get difficult, for making a sustained effort, for trying things they're not sure they can do successfully, can all help teach them the pleasure of pushing themselves. Praise for good grades that come easily can make kids feel they shouldn't have to exert themselves.

Help them see the big picture

 For older kids who have developed an understanding of delayed gratification, sometimes simple reminders of their long-term goals can help push them. Linking school up with their long-term goals can make the work feel more personally fulfilling.

Make the teacher your ally

 Another one of the most important things you can do for your child is to work with his teacher. The teacher might have additional insight about how to motivate your child, or what they might be struggling with. Likewise you can share any strategies or information that you have.


