Preparation and Setup	 Clean and remove damaged or otherwise inferior materials to prepare raw products for processing. Discard inferior materials appropriately. (Reel &Retail) Clean packaging containers, line and pad crates, or assemble cartons to prepare for product packing. (Retail) Request raw materials from material handler at the appropriate times (Reel &Retail) Unwrap raw materials and properly dispose of all unnecessary plastic, bands, strapping, and cardboard. (Reel &Retail) Check board and set up work area for the appropriate product. (Reel) 	4	3	2	1
Packaging and Labeling	 Package the product in the form in which it will be sent out, for example, packaging wire in bags, boxes, or containers, which are shipped to the customer. (Retail) Package the product in the form in which it will be shipped. Stack reels, spools, or flanges correctly on pallet and wrap securely before shipping. (Reel) Attach identification labels to finished packaged items before shipping. (Reel & Retail) Check labels and visually inspect all raw materials to ensure quality and conformity of filled or packaged products to standards. (Bolt, flanges, cores, t-nuts, washers, etc) (Reel) 	4	3	2	1
Safety and Maintenance	 Engage, Maintain, and obey all safety guidelines and procedures (Reels & Retail) When malfunctions occur stop, complete a stop work card, and report malfunctions to a supervisor. (Reel & Retail) Supply materials to spindles, conveyors, hoppers, or other loading devices safely and correctly. (Reel &Retail) 	4	3	2	
Quality Control and Inspection	 Sort, grade, weigh, and inspect products. Verify and adjust product weight or measurement to meet specifications. (Retail) Observe machine operations to ensure quality and conformity of filled or packaged products to standards. (Retail) Reinspect finished product and remove defective products and packaging material before preparing for shipment. (Reel & Retail) Count and record finished products and rejected materials on appropriate paperwork completely, correctly, and honestly. (Reel & Retail) Use the correct tools for each task or job assignment. (Reel & Retail) 	4	3	2	
Machine Operation and Workflow	 Start machine by engaging controls. (Retail) Observe machine operations to ensure quality and conformity of filled or packaged products to standards. (Retail) Secure finished packaged items by bagging, sealing, or attaching fasteners. (Retail) Assemble products according to specific quality standards and customer requirements. (Reel) 	4	3	2	1
