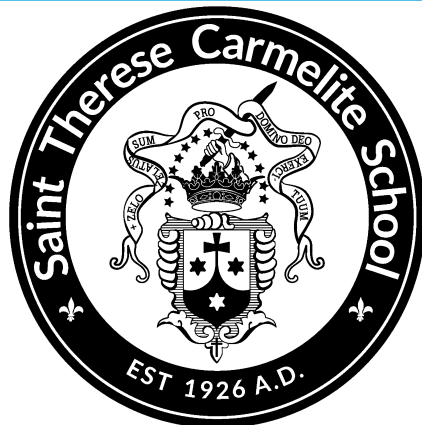

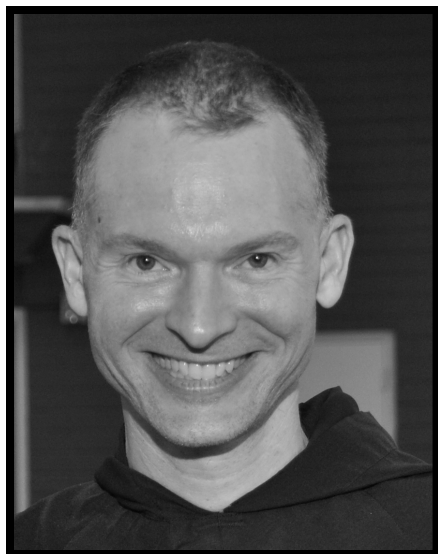

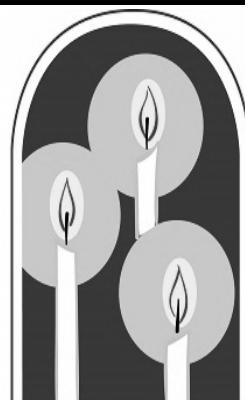
HAPPY ANNIVERSARY, FR. CHARLES!

Please note that, due to the Mass, there will be **NO Exposition/Benediction service** on **Thursday, June 29.**

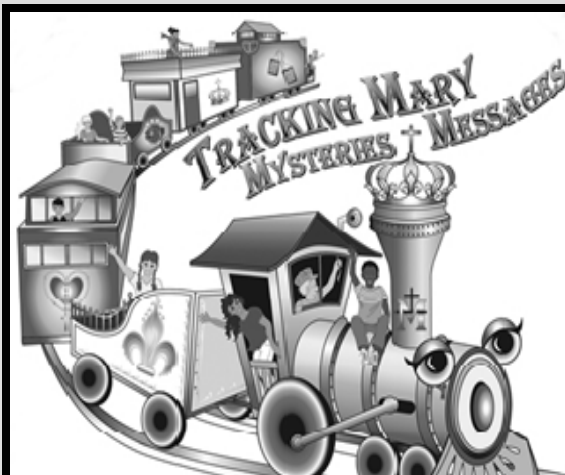
Join Us For Vacation Bible School This Summer! "Tracking Mary: Mysteries and Messages"

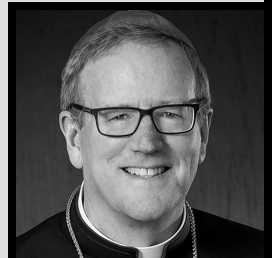


Discover the figures who shaped the Church and changed the world!

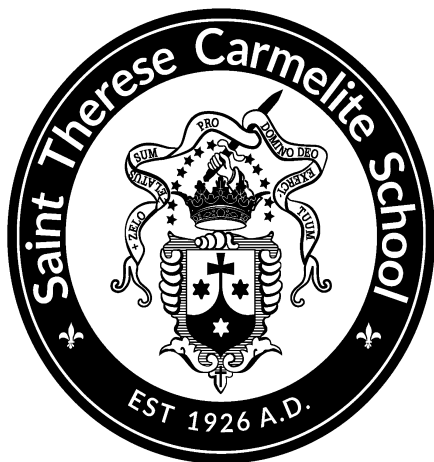

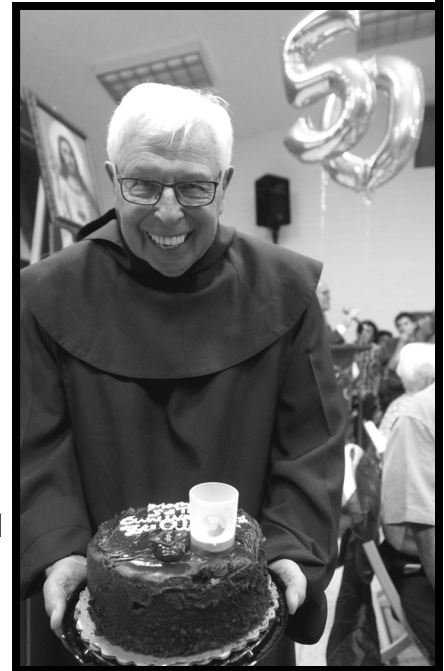
