Attention ALL Parents: Please complete your Online Registration for the next school year.

ALL parents of current 7th and 8th grade students need to complete the online registration process as soon as possible.

Online Registration Directions are included in this newsletter. In addition to the online registration, each student should turn in a health information form and proof of Arizona residency. You have the option to upload proof of Arizona residency; however, if you prefer to provide a hard copy of a document, an additional form must be signed to go with it. You may also email proof of AZ residency to susan.blanchard@lhusd.org. Please make sure to follow the criteria listed on the documentation form.

If you do not complete the online process, a paper packet will be required. If you do not have access to a computer, you may use one in our lobby or request a paper packet (current 7th graders only—8th graders should contact the high school).
