We are also the home of several international industries making us a diverse and global community. Hopkinsville Middle School is one of the two middle schools in Hopkinsville, Kentucky. Hopkinsville Middle School's population consist of 528 students - 257 7th graders, 236 8th graders, Hispanic - 62, American Indian - 2, Asian - 2, African American - 173, Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander - 3, White - 233, Two or more races - 51. Our special education population is 16.3% (86 students). 71% of our students qualify for free or reduced lunch. Our goals are student safety, striving to improve behavior and academics daily, and preparing our student's for the next grade.
