
# Welcome to Ms. Roberts's 7th Grade Language Arts Class




#### COURSE DESCRIPTION

# Technology



Clark-Shaw is a STEM school. We will use technology in this class. The course will be available through Schoology, in addition, tests and timed writing assignments will be submitted through Schoology. Students are expected to use technology responsibly.

## Homework

Students should attempt to read for 20 minutes each night in order to build fluency and comprehension. Other homework assignments will be given periodically and will be listed on the weekly planner board in class.

# Make-up Work

If a student is absent, it is the STUDENT'S responsibility to ask for the missed work AFTER checking Schoology. All daily work will be listed on the agenda shared with students through Schoology. Points may be deducted from the assignment unless the student is absent. If the student is absent, it is his or her responsibility to get work made up within the proper time frame.
