

The FAFSA is changing!

What is the **FAFSA**? If your student is planning any form of education after high school, they must complete (with your help) the **Free Application For Student Aid.** The website to visit is <u>studen-taid.gov</u>. Usually, the FAFSA application opens on October 1st each year. However, due to the extent of the changes made to the application, *it will not open until late December*. This means that there will be a short amount of time to get the application completed before the February 1st deadline. There is something you can do while you are waiting: Have your student set up a login, or FSA ID, on the website above. One parent or caregiver, and possibly more this year, will also need an FSA ID. This will depend on your unique family circumstances and is one of the changes happening this year. Once the login credentials are set-up, it takes a few days for the government to validate that you are a real person and that all of your identification numbers match (Social Security number, birthdate, etc.). You will not be able to enter any information until the official application opens in late December. Join me for a FAFSA/Financial Aid Meeting on Monday, November 13 at 6:00 p.m. in the Moeller Commons. All students and parents are invited; however, junior and senior students and parents are encouraged to attend.

School Notes - Winter Weather Information:

When it comes to the cancellation of school, we will attempt to make that decision as early as possible for everyone's safety and convenience. In making that decision, we will always err on the side of safety for our families. Since the weather can vary greatly across the Saxony attendance area, if we have school but you feel it is unsafe for your student to come to school because of weather related road conditions, please keep them at home. Just call the office to let us know and the absence will not be counted against your student. The safety of all of our students and families is a top priority for Saxony. If we cancel school, it will be announced through the various media outlets in our area. We encourage you to sign up for notifications from KFVS12 or the Southeast Missourian. We will send information through PlusPortals and via our Saxony Lutheran App as well. If you have not done so, please download our app to receive the most up-to-date information as quickly as possible. Weather conditions could also be such that we would have a delayed start or early dismissal. If we have a delayed start, it will be a two hour delay and school will begin at 9:50 a.m. with homeroom. With an early dismissal, we will make every effort to make that decision in a timely manner that allows for the safe transportation home for everyone.


