1. Welcome and Call to Order

2. Inspiration

Quail Run celebrating positive office referrals. Students receive a positive referral and get their picture on the school screens for demonstrating PAWS. Mrs. Kelly is our teacher of the month, and our paraprofessional is Mrs. Rizer.

5. Report of Principal

a. Fundraiser earnings and plans: Teachers would like to spend money on new playground equipment. A portion of the funds will be used for a Step and Repeat, a new table cloth, and the FabLab will build a new podium. All teachers will receive new vests to celebrate being a National Blue Ribbon school. At a later date, we will have a week of celebration for being National Blue Ribbon school.

b. New Parent Engagement Liaison and Cub Connection- Mrs. Gardner is our new liaison and she has created a website where current and upcoming school events are posted.

c. Family Reading Night Feedback- Book tasting and other family reading activities were enjoyed by Quail Run families.

d. A family ESOL Night was hosted on 1/23/24. We were able to share information with some of our ESOL families about how their child is supported through the ESOL program.

e. March 21st is the next Parent University for parents to attend sessions that fit their interests.

f. The Winter Map Assessment Data was reviewed by the committee. The school has planned to incorporate more small group instruction in an effort to improve MAP scores in grades that did not perform as expected.

g. Several new programs and resources were purchased through Title 1 funds. Flocabulary is a new multi-sensory program purchased that works on vocabulary. Frax is a math program purchased for 3rd to 5th grade. Blooket, Brain Pop, and Raz Kids(electronic books) have also been purchased.

h. Phonics program for K-2nd- Mrs. Pellegrino shared positives about Heggerty and UFLI. She has seen success with student spelling and reading growth. The students learn rules and phonics with these interactive programs. MAP Fluency data is a tool that screens students for dyslexia. Several decodable books have been ordered to help teachers with this work.

i. The council took a tour of the school sensory room. Special education classes use the room for de-escalation but also visit the room on a schedule in order to meet students' sensory needs.
