## HHS Tips and Information

- HHS is on a 4 X 4 block schedule.
- That means that there are four 94 minute class periods called blocks. You will take four classes at a time.
- Full credit (1 credit) courses end at the semester. Half-credit (1/2 credit) courses end every nine weeks.

#### Course Selection Sheets

- HHS will select your core subjects (English, Math, and Science) based off your grades, teacher recommendations, Case 21 Scores, State Test Scores, County Office regulations, etc.
- All Freshman will have two options for history courses-Regular vs AP. They may take Govt (1/2 credit) and Economics (1/2), which are regular courses. If a student is interested in the AP route, there are two AP courses-AP Human Geography and AP World History.
- Students must all take an Art, Health, and a PE course their Freshman year, if the schedule allows.
- Students will also be placed in a Computer course, if they did not receive the credit in 8<sup>th</sup> Grade.
- 8 total credits can be earned during your Freshman year. Circle credits totaling 8.
- Course Request Sheets are due Thursday, March 9<sup>th</sup>—Return them to HMS Counselors Office

## Course Selections and Tips

- Select courses that match with your Career Interests, think about Major Clarity.
- Required Electives are typically taken Freshman year. These are Art, Health, PE, and Computer.
- Students may take more than one "art" class at a time. The second class will count as an elective or a CPC requirement.
- All sports will require a try-out. The coaches will give the Counselor's Office the roster, except for Football. You will need Coach Pasterchick's signature.

# Gifted English Course

- Students formerly ruled Gifted/Spotlight will receive a letter with the Summer Reading and course information. This form will need to be signed and returned with your Course Request sheet.
- If you do NOT want to take Gifted English, the packet will also include an Opt out letter-to Opt out of the class. This requires a Parent Signature.
- Either selection, the form <u>MUST</u> to be returned with the Course Selection Sheet.

# Gifted English Course

- Students who are not ruled as Gifted and made 90% or higher on the i-Ready test qualify for the Gifted English class. Those students will receive a letter with information about the class, Summer Reading, and forms for parental consent.
  - The parental form <u>MUST</u> be returned if a student selects this course or Opts out.
