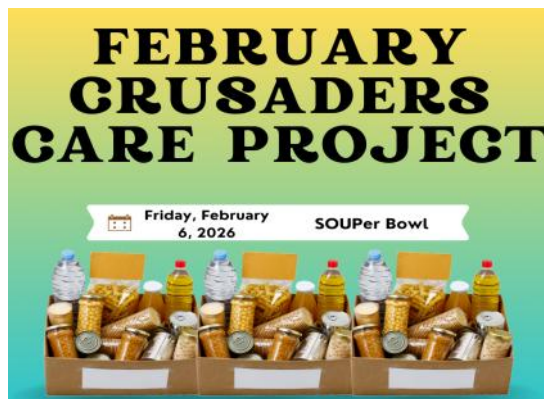

**Subject:** ACT Testing Day – March 10 and Test Prep Opportunity

As a reminder that our school will administer the ACT on **Tuesday, March 10, 2026**

- **All Juniors** will be signed up to take this test. This was paid for as part of the registration costs at the beginning of this year.

**Sophomores** and **Seniors** may take the ACT on this date as well, but **must sign up in advance** if they wish to participate. The cost to take the test here at Saxony will be \$60. Additional details about testing locations, schedules, and what to bring will be shared as we get closer to the date. Please mark your calendars and plan accordingly.

## From the Desk of Mrs. Kiehne:

Happy Winter, Crusaders!

In January, all sophomore class members visited the Career & Technology Center located in (or nearest) their county of residence (Cape CTC and Perryville Area CTC). Any student wishing to apply for a CTC program for next year will need to complete an application and return that to me with any supporting recommendation letters needed by **Friday, February 6<sup>th</sup>, for Perryville Area CTC**, and by **February 12<sup>th</sup>, for Cape Girardeau CTC**. Decisions about program admissions are finalized in late April or early May. Course descriptions and further information about programs available are on the CTC

*Saxony juniors from Perry County also have an opportunity to apply for a special program for the 2026-2027 school year. Representatives from the **CEO Entrepreneurship Program** visited with Saxony Juniors from Perry County on Friday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>, after Chapel. The CEO program credit is provided by the Perryville Area Career & Technology Center in conjunction with Midland Institute for Entrepreneurship and the Perry County Community Foundation of the Ozarks. Students are able to apply for an internship-like program that allows them to attend “class” on-site at a local business every day in the afternoons, like our CTC students do now. More detailed information was given to students, and an online application is open from now until February 27<sup>th</sup>. A letter of recommendation from a teacher or other adult who knows your student well is required.*

I will be visiting Language Arts classes this month to discuss course selection with the ninth through eleventh grades. As students review and revise their four-year plans, it is a good idea for parents to ask to see these and discuss options. More information will be shared as we get closer to making course choices in Plus Portals in late February or early March.

Juniors and parents, please be sure to sign up for a junior meeting time with me as soon as possible! I want to have all meetings completed by the end of February and the times are filling up. Please refer to your email for the link.

March 10th is the in-school ACT for all Juniors and for additional students who also signed up. Please be sure to get a good night's sleep, eat a nutritious breakfast with some protein and carbs, and bring your #2 pencils and an approved calculator. I register the students for the test and students will be instructed about how to set up their MyACT accounts, if they do not have one already. More detailed information will be in an email in the near future.

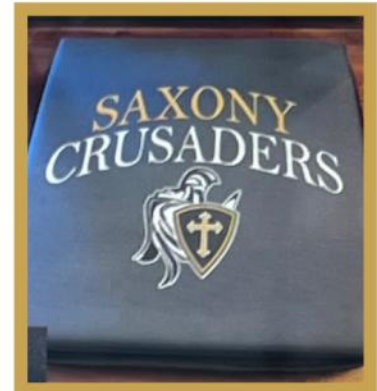



### School Notes - Winter Weather Information:

When it comes to the cancellation of school, we will attempt to make that decision as early as possible for everyone's safety and convenience. In making that decision, we will always err on the side of safety for our families. Since the weather can vary greatly across the Saxony attendance area, if we have school but you feel it is unsafe for your student to come to school because of weather related road conditions, please keep them at home. Just call the office to let us know and the absence will not be counted against your student. The safety of all of our students and families is a top priority for Saxony. If we cancel school, it will be announced through the various media outlets in our area. We encourage you to sign up for notifications from KFVS12. We will send information through PlusPortals and via our **Saxony Lutheran App** as well. **If you have not done so, please download our app to receive the most up-to-date information as quickly as possible.** Weather conditions could also be such that we would have a delayed start or early dismissal. If we have a delayed start, it will be a two hour delay and school will begin at 9:50 a.m. with homeroom. With an early dismissal, we will make every effort to make that decision in a timely manner that allows for the safe transportation home for everyone.

**In the event of a long term weather issue, we will implement our Blue and Gold Day schedule. That information is located on the next page.**

### **Student Expectations for Crusader BLUE/GOLD/WHITE Days**

1. The expectation of Crusader Distance Learning Days is that it will be valuable and move the class forward by one day, just as if we were in school! It is an expectation of all students to join each class via Teams. Each class period will last 15 or 30 minutes depending on the day being BLUE, GOLD, or WHITE, and attendance will be taken.

2. The school day will last from 9:00 a.m. – 11:45 a.m. with a BLUE DAY, GOLD DAY, or WHITE DAY schedule as follows. Communication via email will give the students directions if the Crusaders are on a BLUE, GOLD, or WHITE DAY.

1<sup>st</sup> period = 9:00 – 9:30  
2<sup>nd</sup> period = 9:45 – 10:15  
3<sup>rd</sup> period = 10:30 – 11:00

5<sup>th</sup> period = 9:00 – 9:30  
6<sup>th</sup> period = 9:45 – 10:15  
7<sup>th</sup> period = 10:30 – 11:00  
Chapel/Small Group = 11:15 – 11:45

#### **WHITE DAY**

1<sup>st</sup> period = 9:00 – 9:15  
2<sup>nd</sup> period = 9:25 – 9:40  
3<sup>rd</sup> period = 9:50 – 10:05  
4<sup>th</sup> period = 10:15 – 10:30  
5<sup>th</sup> period = 10:40 – 10:55

3. Teachers will be engaged with the students during these set times for Crusader Distance Learning Days. Class instruction, activities, discussion, and/or assignments will be communicated on Teams during your scheduled class time. Teachers will inform and guide the students on how their class period will function as we work together to create a great learning environment and conduct class in a creative way.

4. As a student, you are expected to join via Teams for each class period and complete all course activities and assignments as instructed by your teacher. All completed assignments need to be submitted by the deadline assigned.

- Teams Etiquette
  - Join and be ready for class at the scheduled time.
  - Be dressed appropriately.
  - Find a good working space where you can sit and be ready for class.
  - Make sure your face is visible during the class, so your teacher knows that you are actively participating.

5. Academic honesty is one of the most important characteristics of a good school, and we expect all students to maintain high standards in all academic settings, including distance learning. All work completed must be your own. You are not to copy, borrow, share work, or collaborate with other students unless the teacher has instructed you to do so. You may not use the internet, or any other sources (including people) not specifically approved by the teacher to complete your assignments. If you are unsure about what academic honesty means for an assignment, check with the teacher.

6. Students, you can contact your teachers via email anytime! To find a teacher's email, log into your email account and search the app "People" OR start a new email message, and click in the "TO" textbox, type the last name of your teacher, and select the correct name in the drop down. Make sure to send proper and respectful emails to contact your teacher. Expect responses from your teachers during normal school hours.

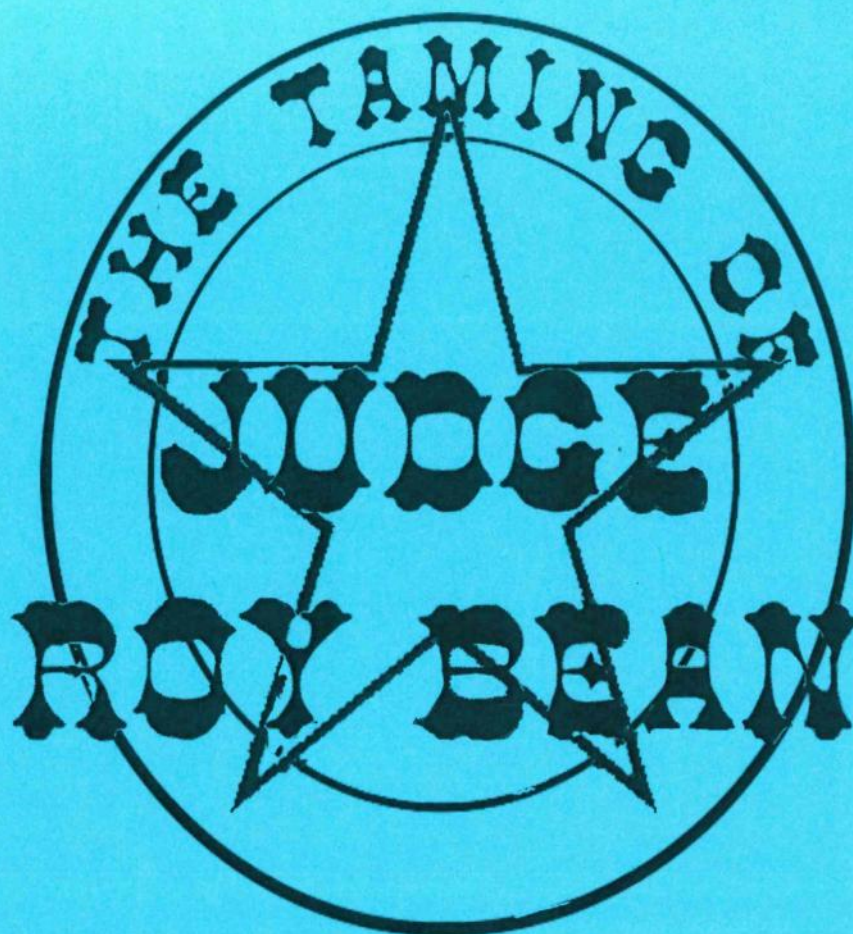
