Practice At Home

- ❖ UFLI at home practice will guide you through the spelling pattern we are learning in class.
- Read 20 minutes each night and record it on your September reading. It is due at the end of the month.

- Math Practice sheets will reflect what we have been learning in class so that you can do a little more at home.

This Week's Agenda

Spelling: two syllable words with open, closed, and CVCe syllables **Reading:** We will read a story called "The Invisible Boy". We will practice asking and answering questions about the story aloud and we'll practice writing responses to questions with complete answers. **Math:** We are working really hard to learn how to determine the value of a digit in varying place values. We will compare numbers with different digits in different places and discuss how they have different values.

Science: We will learn about a few habitats and discuss how they are similar and different to each other. These differences will help us understand why plants and animals live in different habitats.

Social Studies: September 17th is Constitution Day. We will learn about the purpose of our Constitution and how it provides structure to our government.
