Due to COVID-19, state assessments were not given in during the 2019-2020 school year. In 2021, state assessments were given, but scores were waived and only used for data purposes. This year, we will resume back to regular testing and scores will count towards school accountability as well as a graduation requirement for all High School Students. Please see the following schedule below:

Tuesday, May 3rd – 10th Grade English 2 (Multiple Choice and Writing) **
Wednesday, May 4th – 7th and 8th Grade Math
Thursday, May 5th – Algebra 1 **
Friday, May 6th – 8th Grade Science
Friday, May 6th – Biology 1**
Monday, May 9th – US History**
May 10 – May 13th – Make-Up Testing
**Must pass as a Graduation Requirement

All students enrolled in a state-tested area are required to take the assessment. Please make sure your child is well rested, present, and on time the day of the test. We will begin promptly at 8 AM each morning.
