

School Activities Policy

- The Committee sponsoring or planning the activity must obtain the permission of their advisor and administration to schedule any social event. All social events must be adequately supervised. These events will include School Dances and Prom but not be limited to events outside the North Dakota High School Activities governing body or other school clubs that follow their own specific guidelines that have been previously established (FAA or FBLA).
- 7th – 12th grade students enrolled at Glen Ullin High School or are registered with the district as home-schooled are permitted to attend unless activity is designated for a specified age group.
- Guest of these events must seek permission from school administration, one week prior to the event date. No person who has reached the age of twenty-one will be allowed to attend school dances or prom as a guest.
 - If a student has reached the age of 21 but is still enrolled in any school district, attendance at events will not be barred unless not approved by administration.
 - Permission for Guests will be granted using the Guest Request Form.
- Any student who is currently under an active expulsion order from any school district will not be allowed to attend the event.
- Attendees not complying with school guidelines or policies or applicable laws will be required to leave the event, by the Chaperons or Administrators at the event.
- To attend Glen Ullin Public Schools's prom/after prom, attendees must be eligible according to the Glen Ullin Public School academic eligibility policy, located in the Bearcat Extracurricular policy.
