1. **Call to order/Introductions/Pledge of Allegiance**

The meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m. The meeting started with the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. **Approval of Minutes-**

The minutes from the October 12, 2021 meeting were read. A motion was made to approve the minutes with the following amendment:
