

## BOARD MEMBER REMOVAL FROM OFFICE

A board member cannot be removed from office by either the voters or the board itself. Therefore, regardless of performance in office, a board member remains in office until the expiration of his/her term, until he/she is no longer a legal voter in the district or becomes an employee of the district or until he/she resigns.

A board member may not be removed from office except as provided in RSA 32:12 and RSA 42:1-a.
