



NOTES FROM THE PRINCIPAL



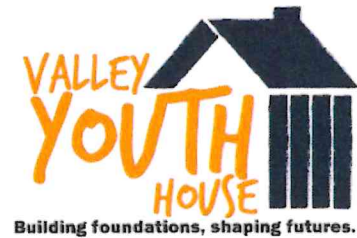

My name is Christopher Lynch, and I am entering into my sixth year working with Junior High basketball program at Bethlehem Catholic High School. The purpose of this email is to inform you of the dates and times of the Junior High tryout. We, at Bethlehem Catholic, want to extend the opportunity for your students to participate with our program. Students who are in 7th or 8th grade and attending a catholic school, are eligible to try out. Last season, we had the pleasure of having three 8th and one 7th grader make the team. The first day of Junior High tryouts will be held at Bethlehem Catholic High School gymnasium on Friday, November 17th @ 7:00 pm and conclude at 9:30 pm. There will be 3 days of tryouts with subsequent cuts after practice on Day 3. The schedule for Friday, November 17th - Sunday, November 19th is listed below:

Day 1 - Friday, November 17th, 7:00 pm - 9:30 pm

Day 2 - Saturday, November 18th, 11:30 am - 1:30 pm

Day 3 - Sunday, November 19th, 2:30 pm - 4:30 pm (cuts to follow practice)
