

Co-sponsored by the Ottertrail Riders Club, this course covers operating procedures, machine maintenance, rules and regulations, accident prevention, outdoor survival, environmental awareness and code of ethics. Both a written test and a riding performance test must be passed. Minnesota law states all residents born after December 31, 1976, must have a safety certificate to operate a snowmobile anywhere in the state.

Please sign up for the Riding Performance Course by Tuesday, December 17th by having your parent/guardian call Jesse Kytta at (218) 639-3683. The workbook and quizzes are to be completed online at snowmobilecourse.com. These materials need to be completed before the Riding Performance Course date. Follow the instructions online, taking all quizzes, etc. Come to class and bring the Student Registration-Parental Release and Self-Certification Form, the form that shows you passed the course and wear warm clothes with a helmet. You will receive further instruction that day.
