








Spotlight on 2nd Grade

 - Ms. McCauley's and Mrs. Rilli's parents will wait by the lower front entrance doors in the front of the building
 - Ms. Liquori's students may be picked up from her outside door near the flagpole
 - Mrs. Forma's students may be picked up from her outside door along the sidewalk
