Kendrick Spring 2023 Driver Education Information

Kendrick High School will be offering a driver education course this spring. Dorie Nelsen is the driving instructor and classroom teacher. Parent/Student Meeting will be at a time to be determined later.

Students must be **14** ½ by February **23**, **2024**, to be eligible. Idaho state law mandates students be 14 ½ by the first day of class, which is **March 4th**. The first 15 students who meet the age eligibility, pay the \$ 150-course fee to Kendrick High School **and** obtain a learner permit, will be added to the course roster. The course will be a combination of online, in-person, and BTW (behind the wheel) instruction. Mrs. Nelsen's schedule is tight. Driving times will be scheduled on the night of the parent/student meeting. Please plan on bringing a calendar.

Please complete the following items in order -

- 1. Pay the district fee of \$150 to Kendrick High School
- 2. Obtain a learner's permit at the Driver License Department
 - a. Call to make an appointment with the licensing department
 - b. Bring the following items to the appointment
 - Picture ID
 - Social Security Card
 - State Certified Birth Certificate
 - Enrollment compliance form from KHS
 - Fee receipt from KHS
 - c. Pay the permit fee of \$26.50
 - d. Students must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian and possess court documents verifying guardianship. Preferably the parent or guardian listed on the birth certificate.
 - e. Provide Mrs. Nelsen with a temporary learner permit #.
 - f. The students actual learner permits will be mailed to KHS and given to Mrs. Nelsen for driving instruction.
