Dear Stewartstown Families,

We hope you had a wonderful summer! It is so exciting to be back at school with all of you. Below you will find information about Stewartstown Community Schools Title I program.

Title I is the largest federal aid program for our nation's schools. It is the outcome of the Elementary Education Act of 1965. At Stewartstown Community School the Title I program is partially funded through a federal grant. The grant allows for our teachers and director to develop programs that supplement the regular classroom instruction. The support instruction is for students most in need of educational assistance. Instruction is offered from kindergarten through grade eight.

The 2021 - 2022 academic school year will offer the following:

- Students may receive Title I instruction in the classroom setting; this method is called inclusion.
- Students may be instructed in a location outside the regular classroom such as the multi-purpose room; this is called the **pull-out method.**
