## Traffic Signals

## Red Traffic Lights

#### Steady Red Light

■ "STOP"



- Stop before stop line or crosswalk
- You may turn right on red unless there is a sign that says "NO Turn On Red"
- Can you turn left at a red light?
  - YES, if you are in left lane and turning left from a one -way street on to another one way street. Unless there is a sign that says otherwise.







## Yellow Traffic Lights

Steady Yellow Light
Slow Down
Yellow light signifies red light will appear soon.
If your entering the intersection and the light turns yellow proceed through carefully.

## Green Traffic Light

Steady Green Light
 Go
 Proceed through intersections
 Yield to pedestrians!



### Arrows

#### Green Arrow

- You may turn in the direction of the arrow
- Your turn is protected, oncoming traffic is at a red light.
- When arrow disappears it would be followed by green light.



### Arrows

Yellow Arrow
Movement is about to end.
Slow down and prepare to stop
If in the intersection proceed with caution

# Red Arrow Not common in Pa. Do not turn in that direction.

## Flashing Signals

 Red Flashing signal
 Treat as a stop sign
 Wellow Flashing signal
 Means caution, slow down

## Lane Use Control Signals

• Green Downward Arrow

Yellow Steady X

• Red Steady X



## Pedestrian Signals

Walk



Finish Walking



Do Not Walk



### School Zone Signals

 Flashing yellow signals placed on the school zone speed limit signs.

 You can not travel faster than the posted speed limit

SPEED LIMIT 20 WHEN FLASHING

 Violating this signal will cost you a citation and 3 points on your driving record.


