#### FLEX

FLEX is a dedicated whole-school time at the end of the day, from 2:25–2:55.

- Once a week, each grade level enjoys an extra lab class while their teachers meet.
- On the other days:
  - **EK-4** students use the time to wrap up lessons or explore new learning opportunities.

**Grades 5–8** work in mixed groups to complete assignments, connect with teachers, and participate in *Character Strong* lessons.

• FLEX is also when many Band and Chorus lessons, as well as ensemble practices, take place.
