Homework-

- This year homework logs will be sent home each Monday along with spelling words to practice for the week. Only the front page, homework log, will need to be returned. The other pages are just for spelling practice. The goal is to do 20 minutes of homework each night. Spelling can count for that 20 minutes.
- Book-It is a program through Pizza Hut that if students reach their reading goal, they get a free personal pizza at Pizza Hut. I have added your child but you must approve it if you would like them to participate. The paper with information on that is in their mailbox. If they turn in their homework logs, I will send out their pizza coupon. Please complete the online form this week.

Classwork-

Each year I get questions about classwork completion. As you look at your student's work you will sometimes see that it is incomplete. During class we don't always have time to finish everything. If you would like your child to finish the work at home for practice that is areat but they do not have to. If there is a required piece of homework, I will write "homework" in a bright color at the top. Please have them finish those pages at home and return them to school.

Library-

Each week we have library time. Mrs. Renfrow's class has library on Wednesday and Miss Fredrickson's class has library on Friday. Please have your child bring their books back each week to check out new books. If you're not finished with the book you are welcome to keep it another week and return it the next. Your child child can only have two books checked out at one time. One that is around their reading level and one "choice" book.

Additional Reminders-

- Change in After School Plans- If your child's after school plan is different from what they usually do, you must notify the school. Your student will then get a yellow note which lets staff know that they are to do something different.
