All entering 12thgrade students are required to have a Meningococcal vaccine (MCV4, meningococcal conjugate) after the age of 16 years per the Pennsylvania Department of Health and Education. If your child has already received the required vaccine, please send this information to the school nurse. Your health provider may fax this information to the school nurse at 717-530-2835. If you do not have health insurance, the vaccines can be obtained from the Pa. State Health Department at (717) 243-5151.

All 11th grade students are required to have a physical examination per the Pa. Departments of Health.

This is a graduation requirement.

There are several ways to fulfill the obligation.

- · Copy of a paper driver's permit or driver's license card (accepted because a physical was required before taking the permit test)
- · Copy of a sport's physical
- · Copy from your private physician's office



March was a busy month with numerous Career Trips. On March 1 several students spent the day at the Aspiring Teachers Summit at Shippensburg University. At this event students heard from a keynote speaker, attended workshops, and toured Grace B. Luhrs Elementary School. March 7 was the DCNR Career Expo where students heard from over 15 presenters showcasing the numerous careers in Agricultural, Conservation and Natural Resources, and Environmental Protection within the Commonwealth. On March 21 students attended a Health and Wellness Expo where students were introduced to career opportunities at UPMC, Wellspan, Cumberland Goodwill EMS, UCP Central PA, and the Arc of Cumberland & Perry Counties. Students also learned about various health care majors at Central Penn College and Penn State University. The Math & Computer Science Day was held at Shippensburg University on March 26. At this event students completed math problems and puzzles alongside current SU Mathematics majors. Students also heard about the growing career of actuarial science.
