What do I have to submit to participate?

Important Dates & Deadlines

- ★ Biographies will be completed during our meeting on **Thursday, September 25**. Final date to accept biography info is **October 3**.
- ★ All dresses must be submitted for approval by **Tuesday, October 21**. Email or submit via Remind a picture of YOU, both front and back, in the dress. Do not buy the dress before receiving approval.
- ★ **Mandatory** Homecoming Court practice for Homecoming Court members will be held on **Thursday, October 30, 30 minutes after the conclusion of the CHS parade on the football field**. *Meet on the home side.*
- ★ The Homecoming parade will be on **Thursday, October 30 at 9:45 a.m.** The parade will start on Striplin Chapel Road as in years past. The parade will then move over to Central High School. More information will be given later, so be sure to check the Remind messages frequently. **Parents will need to go to CES to watch the parade. The car must be street legal. Car or truck only. No boats, atv's, tractors, etc.**
- ★ Sweetheart presentation will begin at **6:15 p.m. on Friday, October 31** on the track facing the home bleachers. Sweethearts will need to be dressed and ready by 6:00 pm. We will meet in the bottom atrium and walk down to the track together.
- ★ King Court will begin at **7:00 p.m. on Friday, October 31**. Court members and escorts will need to be dressed and ready by 6:50 p.m. Meet on the sidelines and begin lining up.
- ★ Queen Court will take place during halftime. Court members will need to report to the 500 hall atrium to line up at the beginning of the 2nd quarter.

Central High School Homecoming Court General Information

Homecoming Court/Sweethearts

It is an honor to represent your school and classmates as a member of court. With this honor comes responsibility. Behavior, social media, and dress must be in accordance with Central High School's Code of Conduct and policies, as well as Board of Education policies established by Carroll County Schools.

Official Dress

Ladies are asked to dress in formal attire, such as a prom dress or formal, dressy floor-length gown, or pantsuit. Dresses must be approved before Friday night's presentation.

Ladies' Escorts should dress in a suit and tie, or shirt and tie, with shirts tucked in. Dress shoes with socks and a belt are expected. **No blue jeans or tennis shoes please.**

Men are asked to wear a suit and tie, or a shirt and tie, or a pants suit. Shirts should be tucked in. Dress shoes with socks and a belt are expected. **No blue jeans or tennis shoes please.** Note: Football players may wear uniforms due to the game that evening.

Men's Escorts should dress in a nice appropriate length dress and/or dress pants with a nice dress shirt. Dress shoes should be worn. **No blue jeans or tennis shoes please.**

Ladies: The new football field surface is rubber and not intended for stiletto pencil size heels. NO PENCIL OR STILETTO STYLE SHOES ALLOWED!

Court members must submit pictures of the planned dress no later than Tuesday, October 21 by 3:00pm. The dress must be pre-approved for entry in the parade lineup and halftime ceremony Friday night.

Late submissions will not be considered.

Photos should be taken with the court member wearing the dress and YOUR face visible. Pictures on a hanger will not be accepted. Dresses cannot have a slit more than 5 inches from the inseam. Low-cut dresses must have a non-flesh colored mesh panel added. Homecoming Court members and Sweetheart members should send pictures to Mrs. Williams via email or Remind.

Parade Signs

Sweetheart parade entries are responsible for creating signs for cars. Signs should include the name of the court member or sweetheart and title, riding in the car.
