COMMUNITY INVESTMENT

Every penny of E-SPLOST comes from a one-cent sales tax shared by everyone who shops in Houston County, not just property owners. This community investment benefits all students, staff, and the entire community.



KEEPS TAXES LOW

E-SPLOST helps maintain a lower property tax. Our current millage rate of 11.719 is the lowest since 1992 and is the 14th lowest out of 180 school districts in the state of Georgia.



WORLD-CLASS SCHOOLS & DIRECT SUPPORT

E-SPLOST funds new schools, major renovations, and expands learning spaces. It also provides safe buses, instructional materials, technology upgrades, and modern security systems. These direct investments strengthen safety, teaching, and learning across the district.

First approved in 1997, E-SPLOST has been continuously renewed by Houston County voters. The 2027–2032 E-SPLOST is a continuation of this proven, one-cent sales tax, demonstrating our community's long-standing commitment to schools, future generations, and Houston County as a whole.


