

Reading Intervention

Purpose: At Dietrich Elementary, we believe every child can grow as a reader. Our Reading Intervention program is designed to give extra support to students who are still developing their reading skills and to challenge those who are already strong readers.

Who does this affect?

All K-6 students at Dietrich Elementary have access to reading support or enrichment.

Goals:

- Help every student become a more confident reader.
- Raise literacy levels across our school.
- Use regular progress checks to see where each student is and give them the right kind of instruction.
- Celebrate student progress and success in reading.

What will it look like?

Frequency: 2x a week for 40 minutes (Mondays & Wednesdays)

Start Week: September 9, 2025

- Currently, teachers are gathering data to form targeted reading groups

When Reading Intervention begins, teachers will utilize a centers/small group model to facilitate the needs of their students. While the teacher meets with a small group,

other students will be working on different reading skills independently.

Teachers will progress check every 2-3 weeks depending on the intervention provided. After progress checks, teachers will either change the groups of students or increase the difficulty of the targeted instruction.

Let's Celebrate

Monthly:

- Those readers who reach their ISIP goal can celebrate over lunch with Mrs. Hampton
- Possible “treat with the Principal” over intervention goal
