

2022-2023 St. John XXIII Catholic School Junior High Supply List

6th Grade Only:

- \$30.00 fee that covers a Bible to be used throughout 6th, 7th, and 8th grade - We will collect Bibles for storage at the end of 6th & 7th grade school years, but students will be given their Bible at the end of the 8th grade year to keep.

8th Grade Only:

- \$45.00 fee that covers 8th grade signature t-shirt and graduation cap/gown

General: required for grades 6, 7, & 8

(Please be prepared to replenish consumable supplies throughout the year. Also, please note, suitcase-style or accordion-style binders are NOT permitted.)

- pencils
- red, blue, and black pens
- highlighters (four colors - at least one of each: pink, blue, yellow, and green)
- colored pencils
- loose leaf paper
- 6 pack of binder tabs/dividers with pockets
- 3x5 lined index cards
- glue stick
- 2 rolls of duct tape, any color
- 2 boxes tissues
- 1 roll paper towels
- 1 clorox/lysol wipes
- pair of headphones or earbuds for use with laptop/tablet device, to be carried to each class
- 1 active- or passive-type stylus* (please see note below for new information)
- plain, white cotton t-shirt for Olympic field day
- (optional) back-up stylus*
- (optional) two-pocket "Homework" folder

**Junior high students are issued a laptop, however a stylus is NOT included. A stylus is required for every student in grades 6, 7, & 8.*

We use HP Probook x360 11 G1 EE laptops, and the only utensil that can be used on the screen is a stylus. Students may not use a finger, pencil, tip of ink pen, or any other item as this can damage the screen. Students may choose between an active or passive stylus; please note that if a student selects the active type, neither teachers nor the tech department will service this stylus if it is not working. We suggest families provide students an inexpensive backup-stylus option in order to prevent a scenario where a student has no stylus in class.

Active Stylus: *An active stylus has a tip like a pen and includes internal electronic components. Features include memory and electronic erasers; it also includes pressure sensitivity that allows lighter or heavier lines depending upon how much pressure is applied.*

Passive/Capacitive Stylus: *Like the active stylus, you can tap or write directly on a screen with a passive stylus (also called a capacitive stylus). Unlike an active stylus, the passive/capacitive stylus does not have touch sensitivity or electronic components. There is no communication between the stylus and the device.*

- two dry erase markers (blue or green are preferred)

- 1/2 inch binder with pockets

- colored pencils for maps & projects (I know it's on the main list, but we really use them, so please ensure you have 1 package)
- a binder just for social studies with 3 dividers with pockets - This is used for note taking, 7 minutes of writing & map day. This is not to be used with other classes!
- loose leaf paper to fill the notebook
- PENCILS (and erasers)- they are the preferred writing utensil in my class
