Parent Access to STAAR Scores

Parents & Guardians Can View STAAR Results Online!

Option 1: Use Your School's Parent Portal

Visit: txfamilyportal.org

 **Have your child's STAAR Score Card ready — the Unique Access Code is located on the first page.**

1. Log in to your child's **school/district Parent Portal**.
2. Look for **STAAR / Texas Assessment / Assessment Results**.
3. Click the link to view your child's STAAR scores.
4. Review your child's performance and areas where additional support may be needed.

Parent Access to STAAR Scores

🔑 Where Do I Find the Access Code?

Your child's **Unique Access Code** is located on the **STAAR Student Report Card/Score Card** provided by the school.

Keep your child's Score Card—it contains the information you need to access detailed STAAR results.

💡 What Can Parents See?

Parents can view more than just the overall score, including **how their child answered individual questions, areas of strength, areas needing support, and resources to help at home.**
