The student shared that it was his favorite class and he elaborated about why it was his favorite class: the teacher was great, and the content was exciting. Ms. Hollander reported the curriculum has been revised to align the use of online materials with district policies. She shared that there were two sections of the class in the fall and two sections offered this semester. It is a half-year course and students earn .5 credit. Approximately 50 students were enrolled in the first semester and the same number this semester.
