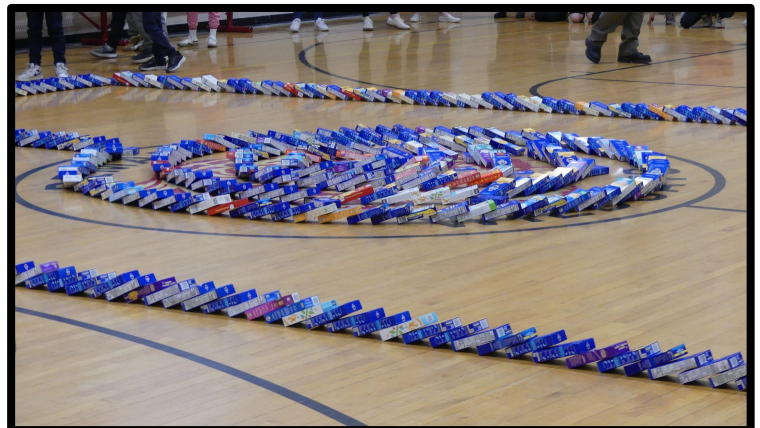

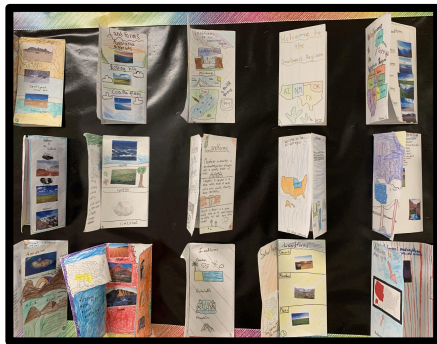




## Spotlight on Fourth Grade
