



Criteria to be considered for National Junior Honor Society

Article VI: Selection of Members

Section 1: To be eligible for membership the candidate must be enrolled as a member of 8th grade or second semester 7th grade classes.

Section 2: Candidates must have a cumulative scholastic average of 87 or above. Candidates shall then be evaluated on the basis of service, leadership, character, and citizenship.

Section 3: A description of the selection procedure shall be published in an official school publication which is widely available, in a timely fashion, to all students and parents of the school. The selection procedure shall be determined by the faculty council and shall be consistent with the rules and regulations of the National Junior Honor Society.

Section 4: The National Council and the NASSP shall not review the judgement of the faculty council regarding selection of individual members to local chapters.
