NON-PUBLIC SESSIONS

The Board of Trustees reserves the right to sit in non-public session when a majority of the members present and voting so vote (recorded roll call vote required). As required by law, the motion calling for a non-public session will indicate the matters to be discussed and the statutory exception stated.

The Principal or his/her designated representative may attend all non-public sessions except those which pertain to the Principal's employment, at the pleasure of the Board.
