Practice At Home

- ❖ Read and write together! After your child finishes reading a story, challenge them to add onto their story in writing OR write a retell of the main events. Pay close attention to spelling!
- ❖ For math, practice adding and subtracting numbers using a variety of different strategies. These strategies might include decomposing numbers, using a number line, or drawing the base ten form of the numbers to add or subtract, etc.
- ❖ Challenge your kiddo to measure items around the house using a variety of measurement units. Then, discuss the difference in lengths and widths of those objects.

This Week's Agenda

Spelling: Schwa can be spelled with the letter 'e' and 'o'
"Schwa" is the lazy /uh/ or /i/ sound that comes in the unstressed syllable of a word. It can be spelled with any vowel, but this week we are focusing on 'e' and 'o'

Examples: even, open, front, cover, among

Reading: We will read a new fable this week and write a retell about the main events and the central message. We are still focused on pollinators.

Math: We are going to switch to learning about simple fractions this week in relation to shapes and number lines.
