

6th grade Supply List:

All students need a **zipper pouch** to keep in their backpacks and hold the following items:

- Colored pencils, markers, **or** crayons
 - A pair of scissors (7" or bigger, not elementary sized)
 - A glue stick
 - Pencils

- One pkg. of **Avery** "Write and Erase Pockets (8 pack)" – The folder and pockets are found at Walmart, Target, and on Amazon. It is important to purchase the **Avery** brand, because the pocket diagonal goes all the way up to the top, and this helps with durability. (See photo below.) Please, do not write on any of the labels; your ELA teacher will help you with this at school.



- 1 composition notebook
- 1 pkg. of highlighters (any color) – Your ELA teacher will keep these in the classroom.
- 1 pkg. of notebook paper (wide-ruled)
- 1 pkg. lined index cards (4x6)

Math supplies:
