Grading Policy

The following is how grades will be weighted in $2^{\rm nd}\,$ grade for each subject.

30% Class Participation- (Ex. math facts, review skills, practice work, homework, Monthly Reading Log, etc.)

40% Formative Assessments- (Ex. Spelling tests, daily work, and quizzes)

30% Summative Assessments- (Ex. Writing prompts, projects, unit tests, and all other major assignments)

Elementary Related Arts:

E- Excellent (100%- 80%)

S- Satisfactory (79% - 60%)

U- Unsatisfactory (59% or below)

Music, Art, PE, and Health grades do not affect Honor Roll or Principal's List. Any questions concerning Related Arts grades should be addressed with the Related Arts teacher.

Transportation Changes
