

Dress Code

Hillcrest Students are expected to wear:

Monday thru Thursday Shirts: Hunter Green Hillcrest t-shirts available online at https://www.pmgschoolgear.com/collections/hillcrest-school-of-the-arts
Or Hunter Green polo type collared shirts.

Friday Shirts: Any color Hillcrest Elementary school shirt available online at https://www.pmgschoolgear.com/collections/hillcrest-school-of-the-arts
Or any Hillcrest Elementary club or organization t-shirt.

Bottoms: Traditional blue jean/denim fabric as well as khaki/tan. These may be in the form of pants, skirts, skorts, shorts, jumpers, or joggers. They must be an appropriate length and fit. Pants or shorts may not hang on the hips inappropriately. Length of skirts and shorts should be mid-thigh or longer. All bottoms must be hemmed, meaning no frayed edges or cut-offs. Belts must be worn with all bottoms that have belt loops.

Shoes: Tennis shoes or sneakers are preferred. No slip-on, slide on, or backless shoes are permitted as they may create a safety issue. Sandals and Crocs with a strap around the ankle are allowed.

General Appearance: No extreme or excessive jewelry, hairstyles, makeup, etc, will be accepted. Excessive or extreme is defined as unsafe, distracting, or interfering with the educational process. The dress code will be enforced in all grade levels.
