Veihl made a motion to officially move to committee-as-a-whole for all committees and also a two meeting per month schedule. Supported by Price. Discussion held.



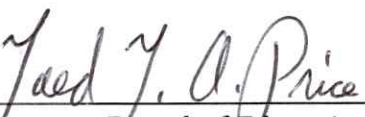
All in favor. Motion carried.
