Dear Parishioners,

Happy Independence Day weekend. I hope that this long weekend for most of us will be one in which we recall the price of our freedom, and remember that our rights come from God, and are to be defended by our government, but also that these rights come with responsibilities.

Personally, I thank God that it seems that we are in the midst of a renewal of religious freedom. The Supreme Court has released three large decisions in the last weeks that are sure to shake the culture. We saw the decision that private prayer is allowed even in public spaces, where law-abiding citizens are allowed their freedoms, and that the radical nature of the federal overreach of abortion on demand with no limitations is returned to the states. (And as such, we have much work to do in our state to seek to end the abomination of abortion as our state laws are radically pro-abortion – state funding for abortions, abortion up to birth, no limits or accountability for abortion clinics, for example.)

Let's be clear, though, with abortion: It is the intentional taking of a human life, and we were among the most extreme nations with no limits on when an abortion could be obtained – our nation was up to the point of birth (and sometimes birth had occurred). Most other nations have some limits, many at 16 weeks. Care for stillborn is not abortion as the child has already passed. Care for ectopic pregnancies is also not abortion as the intent is not to kill the child, but because of where the placenta has attached, the pregnancy cannot be brought to term. There is a unique life in the womb – unique DNA, fingerprints, and heartbeats early on. To say that the worth is subjective – if a mother desires the child it is one, but it is just flesh if the mother does not is philosophically troubled. We do not have the right to kill innocent life – and except in extreme life-and-death cases cannot take the life of the guilty.

No other institution more than the Catholic Church has cared for more orphans and widows, provided education and medical care, and sought to aid women in crisis pregnancies with housing and after the child's birth with diapers, food, jobs or job-training for the mother, etc. These efforts need to continue. The church's members need to step into the breach and continue to provide aid to families and women in crisis as they have done all along. The culture of death is so prevalent around us — it's time we shout the Gospel of Life.

Perhaps one place to start is to re-read (or read for the first time) two very important encyclicals, Humanae Vitae (On

Human Life) by St. Pope Paul VI and Evangelium Vitae (The Gospel of Life) by St. Pope John Paul II. Both of these encyclicals can be found at the www.vatican.va website. I admit that while I have always been pro-life, I understood the stakes more after reading Humanae Vitae. I deeply believe that too many have simply said no to the truth of the church's teaching on life without knowing it, or seeing the difficulty in embracing it, find it too hard and walk away without seeing that true freedom is often difficult. This is the cross of Christ – but by carrying the cross, may we find eternal life.


