




NOTES FROM THE PRINCIPAL

THON™ is a student-run philanthropy committed to enhancing the lives of children and families impacted by childhood cancer. Our mission is to provide emotional and financial support, spread awareness, and ensure funding for critical research—all in pursuit of a cure.

During the mini-THON weekend, dancers and supporters come together in the hopes of one day finding a cure for pediatric cancer. Whether standing for 24 hours as a dancer, being a mini-morale, taking care of the facility, or even standing in the bleachers, every person at THON plays a part in creating an amazing atmosphere of love, compassion, and understanding.

Notre Dame Student Council hosted its first Mini-THON in November 2008. The dancers (81 strong) raised more than \$16,000 for the Four Diamond Fund. Last year, we had nearly 300 dancers and raised more than \$106,000!

Your 7th or 8th grader can participate in this great tradition at ND as a Min-morale by helping with various tasks to keep the dancers occupied and even having an opportunity to stand/dance with our students.
