- **OneCall Alerts:**

If you have not been receiving OneCall text messages from the school, please contact our main office at 216-441-4700 x220 to ensure your information is up to date. OneCall is our primary method of communication for important announcements, including **weather-related school closures**.

- **Cell Phone Policy (Yondr Pouches):**

Every student was issued a **Yondr pouch** at the beginning of the school year to store their cell phone during the school day (7:55 a.m. – 2:40 p.m.). If a student does not have the phone secured in the pouch, the phone may be confiscated and will not be returned until the **end of the next school day**.

- **Dress Code:**

Students must be in full uniform each day, which includes a **school polo, khaki or navy blue pants**, and **appropriate dress shoes**. Only **CCC quarter-zips, cardigans, or sweatshirts** may be worn during the school day; these items are available for purchase in the **Business Office**. If a student arrives out of dress code, a parent or guardian will be contacted to bring appropriate attire to school.
