Dual Enrollment - Credit at THS and College Credit

Examples of courses that count for core credit on campus:

ENG 101 (English 11) Typically taken Fall of Junior Year

ENG 102 (English 12) Typically taken Spring of Junior Year

Classes that do not count for core credit will be on your transcript as elective credit. All Dual Enrollment courses in Chilton County count for .5 weight on your GPA (same as Honors)

NOTE: College Courses can be more rigorous. It is your responsibility to make sure that work is turned in on time and that you communicate with your professor. **Parents are not able to contact your professor on your behalf, it is your responsibility to make sure that you know how to turn in your work, when it is due, etc. Additionally, Each school has different due dates for enrollment and costs, please check their website below for more information. You also may have to take a placement test (ACCUPLACER) or submit ACT Scores before you can be enrolled in a course.**
